Band Directors Report

Treasurer's Report

- Activity Report: Current Unencumbered Balance - \$45,525.02
 - We do have some POs outstanding however the bookkeeper has not entered the POs for Aug
 - Late fee will be assessed after Aug 31st
 - Grace period was given from Aug 18th due to CutTime program issues and statements sent out late.
- Concession Stand Opt-Out
 - Those who indicated they were opting-out of the concession stand shift on the band band registration will be assigned a shift if the \$150 fee is not paid as it was due in May and a grace has been given.

 - Need to know if we will be allowed to drive the Polaris on the new track and if so - what kind of tires will be required
- Chaperone
 - If 9/2 is not a home game, additional chaperones will be needed
